In 1961, Edox launched the Delfin – a timepiece that redefined water resistance and durability, earning the title “The Water Champion.” More than six decades later, Edox opens a new chapter in this legendary line with the new Delfin Mecano Damascus Limited Edition: a bold reinterpretation in a refined 40mm case, now crowned with a forged Damascus steel bezel, each piece uniquely patterned like the waves themselves.

MODERN DESIGN MEETS ANCIENT CRAFT

The redesigned skeleton dial offers a fascinating glimpse into the heart of the movement, exposing the rhythmic precision that defines the Delfin Mecano. The openwork is framed by a one-of-a-kind Damascus bezel, forged using centuries-old techniques once reserved for blades, now channelled into a symbol of endurance and motion. The patterns – never repeated, never predictable – mirror the ever-changing nature of the ocean.

With sapphire crystal, a screw-down crown, luminous markers, and a transparent caseback, this 200-meter water-resistant timepiece delivers all the functionality of a modern diver – but with the soul of something deeper.

LIMITED TO 300 PIECES – NATURALLY UNIQUE

With only 300 units produced worldwide, each watch is more than a numbered edition – it is a singular expression of character and adventure. Whether worn on land or in the depths, it serves as a reminder: no two journeys are the same. No two waves are alike. A contemporary tool watch with heritage in its veins and the ocean in its soul.



ABOUT DAMASCUS STEEL

A LEGENDARY MATERIAL

Damascus steel has fascinated craftsmen and collectors for centuries. Rooted in ancient forging traditions, it was prized not only for its exceptional durability but also for its unmistakable appearance – flowing patterns reminiscent of waves, flames, or wood grain. These motifs are not applied decoratively, but emerge naturally from the fusion of fire, pressure, and time.

FROM FORGING TO WATCHMAKING

Creating Damascus steel requires skill and patience. Multiple layers of steel – often combining different carbon contents – are stacked, forge-welded, and repeatedly folded, then shaped under intense heat and pressure. Once forged, the steel is cut into billets, machined, and heat-treated. Each bezel is then precisely crafted from this material, revealing its organic pattern through an etching process before being carefully fitted to the refined case of the Delfin Mecano.

WHERE CHARACTER MEETS RESILIENCE

Beyond its captivating look, Damascus steel is renowned for its resilience and toughness – qualities that resonate perfectly with the spirit of the Delfin collection. It's the perfect match for a timepiece that blends bold design with lasting reliability.



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ABOUT EDOX

Like time itself, Swiss boutique watchmaker Edox never stands still. Founder Christian Ruefli-Flury was driven by his heart when, in 1884, he made a pocket watch for his beloved wife Pauline's 25th birthday. Delighted, she convinced him to set up his own company – Edox.

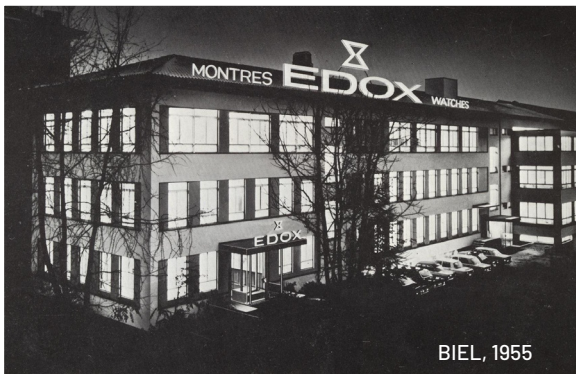
